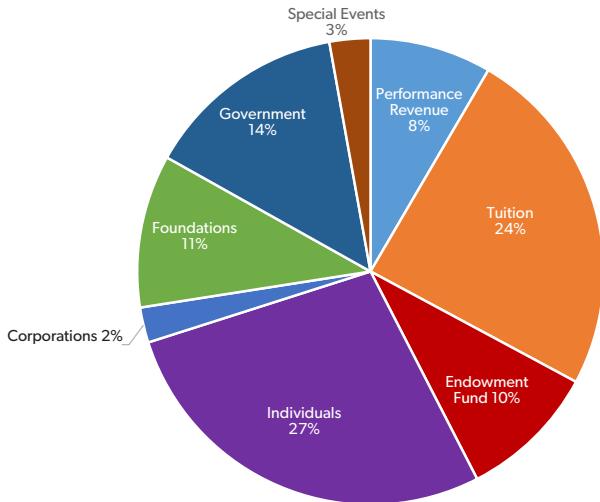
2019-20 ANNUAL REPORT

CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC - March - July 2020

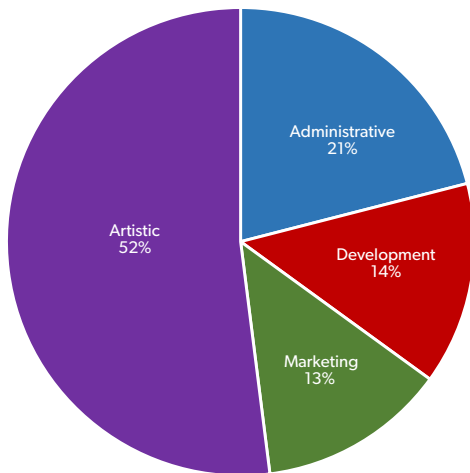
In mid-March 2020, Governor Jared Polis declared a state of emergency in response to Coronavirus (COVID 19) cases in Colorado. Due to restrictions put into place by both Governor Polis and Denver Mayor Michael Hancock, we cancelled all remaining performances (*Spring with the Children's Chorale*, *Spring Fling Sing!*, and *Performing Small Miracles*), as well as scheduled tours and collaborations with other performing arts organizations.

As a non-profit organization, performance revenue and donations are a substantial part of the Chorale budget. The financial impact of cancelling the majority of our annual performances and tours was significant.
